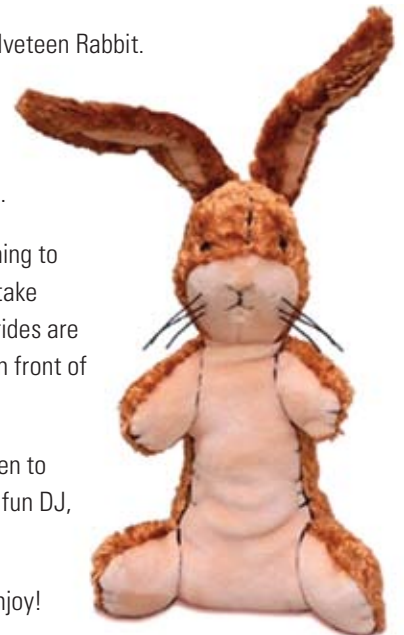
Our party has a theme: The Velveteen Rabbit.

This year's family friendly Grand Illumination will feature Legendary Santa, Snow Queen and the MOPO Bears!



The night begins at 6:00 p.m. with a live countdown to turn on the outline lighting for 15 downtown office buildings. This countdown will be hosted by radio personalities from Lite 98 including Bill Bevins. Snow Queen will emcee the event as she sings, introduces and directs the show.

The VMI Marching Band will perform holiday favorites leading up to the lighting of the REINDEER at 6:25 p.m. Legendary Santa will give the countdown, the lights will come on and the VMI band will lead followers into Shockoe Slip. Next, the MOPO Bears will sing and entertain children with a 25-minute performance.
